BOROUGH OF WOODLYNNE AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE 2006-15

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF WOODLYNNE, COUNTY OF CAMDEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, PROVIDING FOR THE CONTAINERIZATION OF YARD WASTE.

WHEREAS, the prior ordinance did not include the following wording;

Section 2 to now read section 2-a

Section 2-b to read Yard Waste Collection

Sweeping, raking, blowing, or otherwise placing yard waste that is not containerized at the curb or along the curb or along the street is only allowed during the seven [7] days prior to a scheduled and announced collection, and shall not be placed closer than 10 feet from any storm drain inlet. Placement of such yard waste at the curb or along the street at any other time or any other manner is a violation of this ordinance, if such placement of yard waste occurs, the party responsible for placement of the yard waste must remove the yard waste from the street or said party shall be deemed in violation of this ordinance.

WHEREAS, This amendment shall be in full force and effect from and after this date.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Woodlynne that the amendments are approved.
